IS YOUR BUSINESS COMPLIANT WITH CALIFORNIA'S ORGANICS REDUCTION & RECYCLING LAW (SB 1383)?

Beginning January 1, 2022, California Senate Bill (SB) 1383 requires all businesses to separate recyclable and compostable materials from landfill materials by subscribing to recycle and compost collection services.*

Additionally, certain businesses that generate surplus edible food must recover and donate it to a food recovery organization.

This law aims to keep food and other compostable materials out of landfills to reduce greenhouse gas emissions that contribute to climate change.

*Businesses that have an approved waiver or certification of alternative service are exempt from this law. Learn about waiver qualifications and apply at **StopWaste.org/Rules-Waivers**. Learn about and apply for a certification of alternative recycle service at **StopWaste.org/Rules-CRS**.







ASSEMBLY BILL (AB) 1276

This law aims to reduce plastic pollution by requiring businesses to only provide single-use food and drink accessories such as utensils and condiment packets when customers specifically ask for these items. Learn more about AB 1276 at **LegInfo.Legislature.CA.gov**.

PROPER SORTING MAKES A DIFFERENCE!

State and local recycling laws prohibit businesses from placing recyclable and compostable materials in the landfill bin/cart. Garbage cannot be placed in the compost or recycle bin/cart.



Compost

Food scraps, wet and grease/ food-soiled paper, untreated wood, and yard trimmings.



Recycle

Cardboard, paper, glass and metal containers, and plastics labeled #1-2. Keep materials clean, dry, and empty.
